

Use of the Shelburne Town Beach is restricted to residents of Shelburne displaying a Shelburne Recreation sticker on the rear bumper of their car.

However, various Shelburne "based" organizations (schools, service clubs, business firms, etc.) may be given permission, by the Shelburne Recreation Committee, to use the beach area for group parties. The request must be in written form stating date, time, number of people to be present, etc.

If permission is granted, in written form, the regulations listed below must be observed. The regulations were adopted by the Shelburne Recreation Committee at their meeting of August 17, 1971.

REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF
SHELBURNE TOWN BEACH BY SHELBURNE GROUPS

1. Parties are to be limited to Monday thru Friday, excluding holidays, starting after the conclusion of the daily recreation program (about 3:30 p.m.) and ending before the closing of the beach at 9:00 p.m.
2. Strict adherence to Beach Regulations.
3. Clean up must be completed immediately after party with the exception of items like coke machines that are contracted to be picked up. These items should be removed first thing the following morning.
4. A \$50 deposit is required which will be returned if the beach and picnic area are left in satisfactory condition.
5. A police officer will be provided by the Town of Shelburne at the expense of the group conducting the party.

TOWN BEACH GROUP USE POLICIES

- 1.) Group use applications are available at the Parks & Recreation Office. Applications are required for groups of twenty or more. All group use must be approved in advance by the Parks & Recreation Director.
- 2.) Group Use fees are as follows:

Guest Pass (per car).....	\$ 3.00
Non-profit Town Organization.....	no fee
Town Business/Profit Making.....	\$50.00
Town Daycare.....	\$50.00
- 3.) Town Daycare fee is for 1 vehicle. A fee of \$5.00 will be assessed for each additional vehicle. Daycares must provide a staff:child ratio of 5:1 at all times. Beach pass must be affixed to each vehicle on front driver-side bumper, and shown to gatekeeper upon entering facility.
- 4.) A deposit equal to the group use fee is required for all business use. 2 separate checks are requested. Deposit will be refunded upon completion of inspection by Parks & Recreation Director.
- 5.) Groups must collect and bag trash following event. Garbage bags are not provided. Groups will be responsible for any damages to facility.
- 6.) Groups using the beach before or after the regular season, and who wish to use the waterfront, are required to hire a Parks & Recreation Department lifeguard. More than one lifeguard may be required, dependent on group size. Fee: \$10.00 per hour.
- 7.) All group use must be completed by 7:30 p.m. unless approved in advance by the Parks & Recreation Director.
- 8.) All General Park Rules & Regulations, Waterfront Regulations, and Boating Regulations apply to groups.
- 9.) Any questions regarding Group Use Policies should be directed to the Parks & Recreation Director.

TOWN BEACH RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1.) The Town Beach is open from sunrise to sunset. Lifeguards are on duty 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- 2.) A beach pass is required for park use. Only residents of Shelburne may purchase beach passes. Cost for the pass is \$10.00 for the first vehicle, \$5.00 for each additional vehicle. Passes for Senior Citizens (60 & older) are free. Guest passes are available for \$3.00 per day per vehicle.
- 3.) Parking is limited to authorized areas only. A current beach pass must be displayed at all times. The beach pass should be affixed to the front bumper.
- 4.) Swimming is allowed in area marked by buoys only.
- 5.) No bottles, glass, or cans in beach area.
- 6.) Jumping only allowed off raft. No dives or flips. Pushing and/or rough play is not allowed.
- 7.) No flotation devices allowed. Town kickboards may be borrowed for use in designated area if conditions permit. Final decision to be made by Beach Supervisor on duty.
- 8.) Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- 9.) Alcohol is prohibited in all areas of the park.
- 10.) Boats, sailboards, and/or motorized crafts are not permitted in swimming area. Boat launching and/or beaching permitted as per boating regulations. Boating regulations are posted at boating area.
- 11.) Open fires are not permitted.
- 12.) Pets are not allowed in any area of the park.
- 13.) Firearms and/or explosives are prohibited.
- 14.) Beach Supervisor on duty will have final authority on safe swimming conditions.
- 15.) Infractions of the above rules & regulations will be dealt with by the Beach Supervisor on duty.
